



## **Year 11 Revision Resource Guidance**

Students will undoubtedly now be planning their revision timetables ahead of the Easter break and checking to make sure that they have everything they need to be able to work independently on their final exam preparations.

Below is a snapshot of where students can find revision resources for each subject. We have tried to keep this simple, so have given subject-wide guidance, but there may be small variations within larger subjects where there are more teachers. Therefore, students should ensure that they use this guide to check with their subject teachers (tick box when completed) where to find resources online, so that they have everything in hand before they break up. There is a fantastic offer of Easter revision sessions for subjects across the curriculum; students will get their bespoke timetable shortly, but it would be a good idea for them to note their sessions on here too, in the space provided.

These are particularly useful as they are broken down into Higher, Crossover and Foundation Skills, and then further divided into the different strands of the curriculum (Number, Algebra, Ratio and Proportion, Geometry, Probability and Statistics). Each topic has it's own Sparx Topic Code, which you should use on the <b>Independent Learning section of SparxMaths</b> for any topics that have been identified as a weakness.</li> </ul>
